SCHOOL UNIFORM PROCEDURES

Procedures

All students are required to wear the School uniform as prescribed by the School. Each item of the uniform must be kept clean, pressed and in good repair.

Full School uniform must be worn at all times to and from the School and at all sporting functions, unless otherwise stated. The wearing of jewellery, except items specified by the Principal/Director is not permitted.

General Requirements

- Students must have a conventional hairstyle and hair colour. Hair should be clean and tidy. Boys' hair should be short and neat. No steps or undercuts are allowed. Girls' hair that touches the collar should be tied back. No streaks are allowed. No hair gel or other products are allowed. Hair accessories must be navy blue.
- Jewellery – The only jewellery that may be worn is a wristwatch, one pair of small stud earrings or sleepers and a Christian cross. Earrings are not to be worn high on the ear. Boys are not to wear earrings.
- Makeup – The use of makeup and nail polish is not permitted.

Additional Uniform Items

- School sun hat must be worn every day. Students are not allowed to play in the sun without their School hat.
- School bags – students are allowed to carry a St Euphemia bag or a plain blue or black school bag with no writing on it.
- In the case of wet weather, students are allowed to wear a raincoat. No umbrellas allowed.
- Sport uniform for Infants may be worn on Thursdays and Primary on Fridays.

It is compulsory to own a blue formal hat. This hat must be worn during School ceremonies and on some School excursions.

Sport and PE

- St Euphemia College polo shirt
- St Euphemia College blue shorts
- St Euphemia College track pants and jacket
- Joggers

Students are to wear the School sports uniform (polo, shorts, jacket, pants) for PE lessons on Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. If they have a PE lesson during Period 1 or 2 they can come to school in their sports uniform. If they have a PE lessons during the last period, they can leave the School in their sport uniform. Students are not permitted to stay in their sports uniform for the entire day.

On Tuesdays, students are to wear the School sports uniform. Those who have represented the School at the Orthodox Carnival can wear the Orthodox sports uniform. This is NOT allowed for PE lessons on any other day of the week.

SWISSA or AICES sports tops should not be worn during Tuesday sport or PE lessons, as these events are held off the school grounds.

Appropriate footwear must be worn. All shoes must be laced with adequate support, cushioning and soles to prevent injury.

Students are to travel to and from School dressed in the full school uniform. Students who wear their PE uniform outside PE and sports lessons will be in breach of the Uniform Policy and Procedures and will receive a uniform demerit.

Year 12 students are permitted to wear their School Jersey on Tuesdays and Fridays.

Administration of the Uniform Policy (High School)

It is the responsibility of all students to follow the School's Uniform Guidelines and Procedures. If a student is in breach of these Procedures, then they will be given a demerit. Five demerits will amount to an afterschool detention.

The student's demerit will be entered by the teacher in the School's database against the student's name and will include the nature of the infringement.

After 3 uniform detentions, a letter will be sent home to parents by the Uniform Coordinator, informing them of their child's breach of the Uniform Policy and Procedures and as a consequence, the student will be placed into time out.

This will be a permanent record and will be used by staff to comment on appearance in school reports.

Supplier of School Uniform

There is an onsite School Uniform shop. The Uniform Shop is open on Tuesday and Thursday between 2.00pm – 4.00pm. It is situated on Level 1 of the School Hall, next door to the Church on East Terrace.
