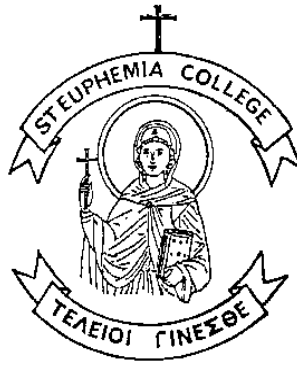

1. TUESDAY SPORT

2. PHYSICAL EDUCATION

It is compulsory for all students to participate in various physical activities as scheduled in the Physical Education program. To cover a wide variety of sports and activities, it is sometimes necessary to use the adjacent **Stevens Reserve**.

3. PARTICIPATION AND SCHOOL SPORT UNIFORM

Participation and school sport uniform are **compulsory for all students** during Tuesday sport and Physical Education lessons.

Students who do not bring their full school uniform to change back into following **Physical Education lessons** (where required) will have their names recorded. If this is to occur 3 times, an afternoon detention will be assigned.

If, during **Tuesday sport** or any **sporting day/commitment** such as **SWISSA, AICES Gala Day**, a student is not in full sports uniform, and a note has not been provided by the parent or caregiver, they will not be allowed to go to the Tuesday sport venue or sporting event. If student has a note from their parent or caregiver, they will be able to attend, however a demerit will be assigned and if this is to occur 3 times, an afternoon detention will be assigned.

4. TRANSPORT TO AND FROM SPORTING EVENTS

Unless a written note signed by a parent or caregiver has been approved by the Principal, **no student, under any circumstances** is allowed to:

- travel to and from a sporting venue/carnival by e.g. car, train, taxi or public bus
- transport other students i.e. take other students as passengers in his/her car.

Where students need to be transported to and from the sporting event/carnival by their parents or caregivers, a **written note, signed by a parent or caregiver** must also be approved by the Principal prior to the date of the sporting event/carnival.

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SWIMMING CARNIVAL – FRIDAY 1 MARCH 2019

Dear Parents / Caregivers:

The High School Swimming Carnival will take place on Friday 1 March 2019 at the Birrong Swimming Centre (Wellington Rd, Birrong). Students will travel to the carnival by bus, departing school at 8:45am, returning at 3:10 pm.

It is compulsory for all students to attend all school sport carnivals. All students are encouraged to participate. Students not participating must provide a note stating the reason for their non-participation. Students are allowed to wear their sports uniform or team colours. All competitors must be in appropriate swimming attire. Females must be in one piece swimming costume - no bikinis. If any student is wearing inappropriate/revealing clothing (strapless, halter neck, miniskirts or shorts etc) or has inappropriate slogans displayed, they will stay back at school.

Unless a written note signed by a parent or caregiver has been approved by the Principal, no student, under any circumstances is allowed to:

- travel to and from the carnival by e.g. car, train, taxi or public bus
- transport other students i.e. take other students as passengers in his/her car.

Where students need to be transported to and from the carnival by their parents or caregivers, a written note, signed by a parent or caregiver must also be approved by the Principal prior to the date of the carnival.

Students are encouraged to bring their own food and drinks however, canteen facilities will be available. Students should also bring a hat, sun-block, towel, swimming costume, streamers and banners (if possible).
