Extended Leave - Travel

At St Euphemia College, we place a strong emphasis on regular attendance, as it is key to academic success, personal development, and social connections. It is also a requirement under the Education Act 1990.

While we understand that there may be occasions when students require leave, we kindly remind families of our Student Leave for Travel Policy.

Under this policy:

- Parents may request leave of up to seven school days, with approval for longer absences granted only in exceptional circumstances.
- Leave for general family holidays during term time is not approved unless there is a significant reason.
- Major school events—including assessment periods, Divine Liturgies, Speech Day, and sports carnivals—should be prioritised, and leave should not conflict with these.
- Requests for extended leave must be submitted at least five weeks in advance and will be considered based on factors such as attendance, previous leave, academic impact, and behaviour.
- Unapproved absences may be marked as unjustified and could impact enrolment.
